NOTES:

1. Minimum of **53.5 semester credit hours** are required for graduation.
2. Students are required to be enrolled in a minimum of six courses for credit during each semester to be considered as full-time students.
3. Students must attend eight semesters of high school full-time at Christian Heritage Academy (unless transfer credits are accepted from an approved institution) in order to graduate and receive a diploma.
4. Upper School students must meet all graduation requirements to receive a diploma from Christian Heritage Academy. A student may elect to leave CHA prior to 2nd semester their senior year, however, a diploma will not be granted.
5. Seniors are required to take the ACT or SAT college entrance exam prior to graduation and submit this score to CHA as well as their plans for post graduation.
6. Summer tutoring for students is permissible and even advisable for purposes of remediation. However, tutoring is not recognized as a substitute for or in lieu of academic coursework and course completion. Tutored students will not receive a letter grade nor receive high school graduation credits for tutoring. Students who need remediation for incomplete coursework have several options:
 - a. summer school through public or private high schools
 - b. online coursework through pre-approved programs through virtual high schools or
 - c. community college or local college coursework

Each of these options must meet the objectives/guidelines for the equivalent course at CHA and be pre-approved by the Administration prior to enrollment.
