Understanding the purpose and mission of Christian Heritage Academy, we want to develop a life of faith and obedience in our students, based on God's standards, laid out in His Word. While some of these standards are detailed and specific and others are more general, we want to encourage our students to live in a manner that glorifies God in every area. Our lives will be enriched by applying these truths in a consistent manner. In keeping with these beliefs, it is to be understood that Christian Heritage Academy expects its students to:

1. Cultivate an active and authentic relationship with Jesus Christ.
  - a. This includes studying God's Word, maintaining an active prayer life, being part of a church community, making oneself accountable to others, and seeking to share Christ through word and deed.
  - b. Also, students should make every effort to avoid influences that create a heart divided from the Lord. This includes what one views and listens to, recognizing that anything that mocks or disregards biblical standards can be destructive to a life of faith.
2. Treat others with respect and love.
  - a. Encourage one another and build each other up (1 Thess. 5:11) – This requires us to treat others with kindness, and respect at all times. It also requires us to be a positive influence in the lives of those with whom we associate.
  - b. Communicate with others in a spirit of love. This requires us to refrain from such things as gossip, anger, unkind words, and cruel jokes at the expense of others.
  - c. Develop relationships that edify our relationship with Christ and spur us to live righteously (1 Corinthians 15:33).
3. Live a life of integrity.
  - a. Respect authority. This includes the authority of our parents, as well as the school and greater community. Living daily with one's parents and under their authority is a requirement to be a student at Christian Heritage Academy (1 Thes. 5:12).
  - b. Be honest and above reproach. We must always speak truth, and avoid any appearance of dishonesty (Proverbs 8:7). This includes avoiding such things as stealing, lying, cheating, and deception.
  - c. Demonstrate self-control (James 1:19). We must avoid allowing our behavior or responses to a situation to be a hindrance or a distraction to the community as a whole.
4. Maintain God's standards for morality, purity and righteous living.
  - a. Students are expected to flee from the presence and association of any inappropriate or illegal activities (Ephesians 5:3-7). This includes but is not limited to activities such as: possession and use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, controlled substances, and gambling.
  - b. Students are expected to maintain purity in all areas of their lives. This includes but is not limited to things such as: refraining from sexual relations, homosexual behavior, and pornography (either printed or virtual).
  - c. Apply God's Word to every aspect of our life in today's world. We expect Christian Heritage Academy students to adhere to these guidelines at all times, both in and outside of school.
